Sri Nammalwar Jayanthi Monday May 28th 2018, 10 AM



Nammalwar (Nammā<u>l</u>wār)

Nammalwar was born in 43rd day of Kali of 3059 BC in Thirukurukur (modern day Alwarthirunagiri near Tirunelveli). When he was born, he responded to no external stimuli and his left him the feet of the parents at deity of Sri Adhinathar in Alwarthirunagari. The child then got up and climbed into a hole in a tamarind, sat in the lotus position, and began to meditate. It appears he was in this state for as long as sixteen years when a Tamil poet and scholar in named Madhurakavi Alvar. Nammalwar broke his lifelong silence and responded to Madhurakavi Alvar philosophical questions. Nammalvars considered an incarnation of Vishvaksena. The Garuda Sevai utsavam in the month of Vaikasi witnesses nine Garudasevai, an event in which utsavars from nava tirupati are brought on Garuda vahana representing that lord himself gave darshan to Nammalvar in all the forms of Divyadesams and Nammalvar composed verses praising the perumal in each Divyadesam. Nammalvar is also known as Settagopudu (representation of Setta-Ari) given in vishnu temples that carries Vishnu padams.
