Sri Rudram hymn is an invocation to Lord Siva. Sri Rudram consists of two parts, namely, Namakam and Chamakam. Namakam sings the glory of Lord Siva and Chamakam is requesting the Lord to grant the devotee materialistic and spiritual grace so that he/she can elevate himself/herself and serve Lord's creation in this universe. Each of Namakam and Chamakam consists of 11 chapters called "Anuvakams"

Eleven rounds of Ekadasa Rudram chanting constitute a "Sri (Laghu)Rudram"
