



Margazhi (Dhanur) Maasam Program

Worship of Lord Vishnu and Andal (Goda Devi) during the morning hours in Dhanurmaasa is considered highly auspicious. There is a belief that worshipping Lord Vishnu on a single day during Dhanurmaasa is equal to worshipping him for thousands of years. Thiruppaavai and Nachiyar Thirumozhi, two divine texts are composed by Andal. Every day, AHT will recite Thirupalliyezucci & Thiruppaavai followed by Pongal Prasadam. AHT is also organizing several vishesha (special) sevas for the Lord which include Deepa alankara Seva, Oonjal Seva, Bhogam and Sanchara Seva (at Devotees homes).
